#### MAJOR FINDINGS:

It was found out that 90.90% of the male Political Science students strongly agreed that they have sex with a female partner than of the same sex and 63.63% agreed that they never indulged in pre-marital sex. Thus, their views and ideas conformed with their lessons from Theology 6 class. 72.72% strongly agreed that they preferred foreign pornographic films than local pornographic films. Thus, hard core pornographic film greatly affected male behavior towards sexuality. The two coping mechanisms were available to them were displacement and denial.

### CONCLUSION:

Based on the findings, it was concluded that majority of male Political Science students of the De La Salle

University - Aguinaldo, SY 1995-1996, perceived that pornographic film is a factor in their sexuality.

#### RECOMMENDATIONS:

Based on the findings and conclusions, the researchers recommended:

- 1. A similar study be conducted using a larger group of respondents and include the entire aspect of male sexuality.
- 2. That the importance of moral values not only regarding sex but the person as a whole be stressed in the academic community.
- 3. Laws regarding pornographic films should be strictly implemented.
