## A B S T R A C T

This exploratory and correlational study sought to determine the Roxas Boulevard ago-go dancers' self-concept and the relationship that exists between the two. It was decided that this study be conducted through test administration and interviews.

The respondents for this study were selected through purposive sampling since they should be between the age range of 13 to 18 years old.

The researchers of this study made use of three instruments. The first was used to gather background and supplementary information. The second instrument was the Pasao Self-Concept Rating Scale to determine their degree of self-concept. The level of perceived job satisfaction of the ago-go dancers was determined through a self-constructed rating scale, which was pretested and item analyzed.

After making an analysis of the ago-go dancers' responses, it was learned that: they have a high self-concept, they are highly satisfied in their job and there is a high positive correlation between self-concept and perceived job satisfaction.
