ABSTRACT

study described perceptions of death school children and the Metro Manila among differences of these perceptions according to subjects' age, sex, religious affil.ation, exposure to death. This was achieved by conducting interviews with the one hundred thirty two male and female school children whose ages ranged from four to twelve years and came primarily from Dur Lady of St. Stephen's High (Catholic), Lourdes School (Protestant), and New Era College (Iglesia School Cristo). Data obtained were content analyzed and significant results showed that among children of the different ages, sex, religious affiliation, and exposure to death were generally the same, predominantly that of extinction or the end physical life and the next of which was afterlife.
