ABSTRACT

The study done basically deals with the concepts of death among Filipinos. The concepts were compared across the different age brackets, sex and socioeconomic status. It expounds on the similaria ties and differences of the people against the sixteen (16) factors taken from the seventy (70) item questionnaire made by Chua, Dumayas and Mercado (1981). One hundred and eighty (180) Filipinos residing in Metro Manila were taken as subjects and were given the questionnaires. Their answers reflected how these people, belonging to the different categories mentioned, viewed the concepts of death. The data obtained was then analyzed using the sixteen (16) factors. The results show that age, sex and socioeconomic status of Filipinos do not affect their views about death.
