## ABSTRACT

This study entitled A Study On The Perception Of Household Helpers and Employers on Some Aspects of Their Relationship wants to determine the pattern and the difference between the employer and helper's perception on their relationship, particularly on the aspects of Trust, Manner of Giving Requests/Commands/Amount of Workload and Concern.

The study utilized the Likert summative scale for both the employer and helper respondents. The only difference lies in how data were gathered. For the helper respondents, data were obtained through personal interview. On the other hand, a self-administered questionnaire, containing the same questions, were given to the employer respondents.

Results revealed that there was no significant difference between the employer and helper's perception on their relationship. The factors found to affect the helper's perception were: Helper's age, number of tasks per helper, number of helpers, and, Helper's salary. For the employer respondents, the factors found to affect their perception were their educational attainment and age.
