ABSTRACT

Jennifer C. Pe and Catherine Rose Yu, "A Study of Comfort Room Graffiti Written by Males and Females". An undergraduate thesis in A.B. Psychology, De La Salle University. December, 1987. The study investigated the different types of graffiti found in the restrooms of twelve selected moviehouses in Metro Manila. Stratified Random Sampling was used in obtaining the moviehouses where all graffiti were collected. Moviehouses were divided into three groups, Class A, B and C. Four moviehouses represented each class. The instruments used were Pen and Paper used for collecting all graffiti in the restrooms and a mimeographed questionnaire for the face validity. Sex of the graffiti writer and the classification of the moviehouses were factors considered in the analysis of the data gathered.

Findings obtained in the study showed that the different types of graffiti found in selected moviehouses were Political, Sex, General Insults, Sequential, Music, Gang, Romantic, Area and Miscellaneous graffiti. There were a total of 714 graffiti collected. Sequential graffiti appeared most-having a frequency of 312. Music graffiti was the least written graffiti. Males wrote more graffiti than females.
