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ABSTRACT

This is an exploratory study to investigate the different factors that would account for stress and adjustment in intermarriagea. The researcher focused on the perceived areas of tension, specific coping strategies and the role that each member of the Filipino-American, Filipino-Spanish and Filipino-Chinese couples played in handling problems that arose due to cross-cultural differences.

The study made use of the multi=methos approach in order to cross validate **findings**. It included the use of a questionaire, interview, and of pakikiramdam. Due to the infrequency of such intercultural marriages, the researcher utilized a purposive sampling. Moreover, the ten couples in each type on intermarriages, five of them are Filipinos married to a wife who is of another culture and five of them Filipinas married to a husband of another culture. Findings show that there are no potensial conflict posed by the cross-cultural aspect.



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
