

## ABSTRACT

The attempts to gain adequate information that will provide a better understanding of the fortune tellers based on the four dimensions: physical, intrapsychic, socio-cultural, and spiritual. Results indicate a pronounced uniqueness of each fortune-teller regarding concepts of reality, people, soul, God and religion. Common to all is a desire to be of service to others ~~making it also a~~ the reason behind their drawing power. In this study, fortune telling was found to be their main source of livelihood, a cause for their strong sense of social desirability. Most of them have develop their potentials through the use of books and constant encounter with people. Thus, one need not have psychic abilities to be able to become a fortune teller.
