#### **OBJECTIVES OF THE STUDY:**

#### A. GENERAL:

To analyze the concept of friendship among Caviteno students of De La Salle University - Dasmarinas.

#### B. SPECIFIC:

To identify the most common concept and indicator of friendship among Caviteno students of De La Salle University - Dasmarinas.

#### **SCOPE AND COVERAGE:**

The study focused mainly on Cavitenos and their concept of friendship. It also included their indicators of friendship.

#### **METHODOLOGY:**

A descriptive method was used in this study. The respondents were selected Arts and Sciences students of De La Salle University - Dasmarinas who had been residing in Cavite for at least 5 years. The researchers made use of a constructed questionnaire, where in qualified students were asked to define friendship and its indicators. The data were presented by tallying the frequency and rank from highest to lowest.

#### **MAJOR FINDINGS:**

From the data collected, the researchers came up with the following findings:

- 1. That the highest concept was in the category of valuing friendship which is something that must be treasured because this is one of the most precious gift;
- 2. Both male and female concepts were one in valuing friendship as it got the highest category.
- 3. The highest indicator of friendship among Cavitenos was the category of sense of worth, followed by companionship, acceptance and compatibility.

#### **CONCLUSIONS:**

Based on the above findings, the following conclusions were drawn:

 Cavitenos consider friendship as a basic need and fundamental in a human relationship.

- 2. Male concept of friendship places greater emphasis on pakikisama and sharing common interest while female concept was more personal. It is evident that female are more affectionate and open-minded about friendship because it includes sharing intimate secrets, caring and having more opinions and views.
- 3. Both genders agreed, that the indicators of friendship are companionship, openness/acceptance, compatibility and sense of worth.

#### RECOMMENDATIONS:

After a careful review of the findings and analysis of data, the researchers came up with the following recommendations:

To improve interpersonal relationship and socialization among students,

- a. the administrators, through the different service department, should create programs and activities for students to cultivate their friendship factor;
- b. teachers should establish rapport with students inside and outside the classroom to maintain a healthy learning environment.
