

BARO'T SAYA: A PROPOSED FASHION TECHNOLOGY INSTITUTE

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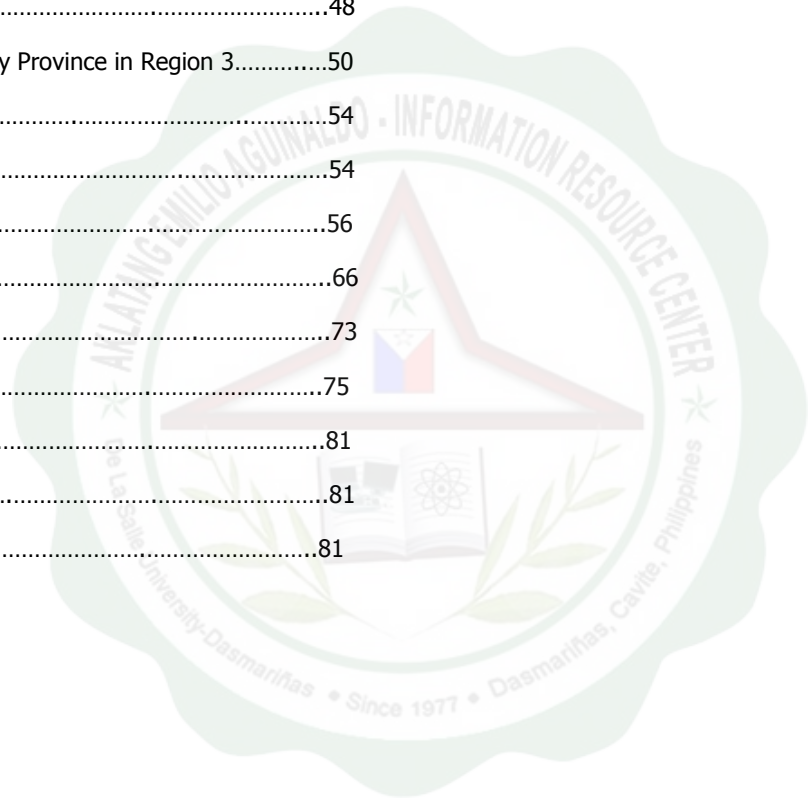
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Abstract of the Study

This project proposal focuses in enhancing cultures and arts of our society but through architectural solution of a fashion school. Since our young industry in fashion is starting to create a new and bigger industry, this proposal aims to conserve and preserve our cultural way of making cloths, especially hand woven fabrics using indigeneous materials like "pina", "jusi" and "abaca". This proposal includes both old ways of weaving cloth and new ways to improve the skills of our fashion designers for them to be competitive in real world, both inside and outside the country. This project proposal is different from those ordinary schools. It has specific activities, different circulation of users and type of users. It offers both short and bachelor programs.

To be able to give solution for the proposal, this study was completed through various related project visitation to know the specific areas needed for a fashion school. Bachelor of Arts in Fashion Design and Marketing Curriculum was also studied to be able know the various spaces

needed to accommodate the needs of the different users. For general design guidelines of a school, this study was supported by various standard guidelines especially by CHED requirements in school design and plans. The methodology used to conduct the study, especially architectural drawings, is my own theory but with the guidance of thesis adviser, from selecting site up to determining the spaces needed. It was formulated through various interviews from students to higher officials of a school.

"Baro't Saya: Proposed Fashion Technology Institute" is a proposal of intelligent building on which it provides the different requirement of a fashion school in terms of planning and designing of school. The designed also maximizes the use of tropical climate, natural lighting and ventilation. It uses different features and materials to maximize the circulation of air from outside to inside of the structure.
