RECOMENDATION: System should be upgraded time to time to provide the latest information to the users.

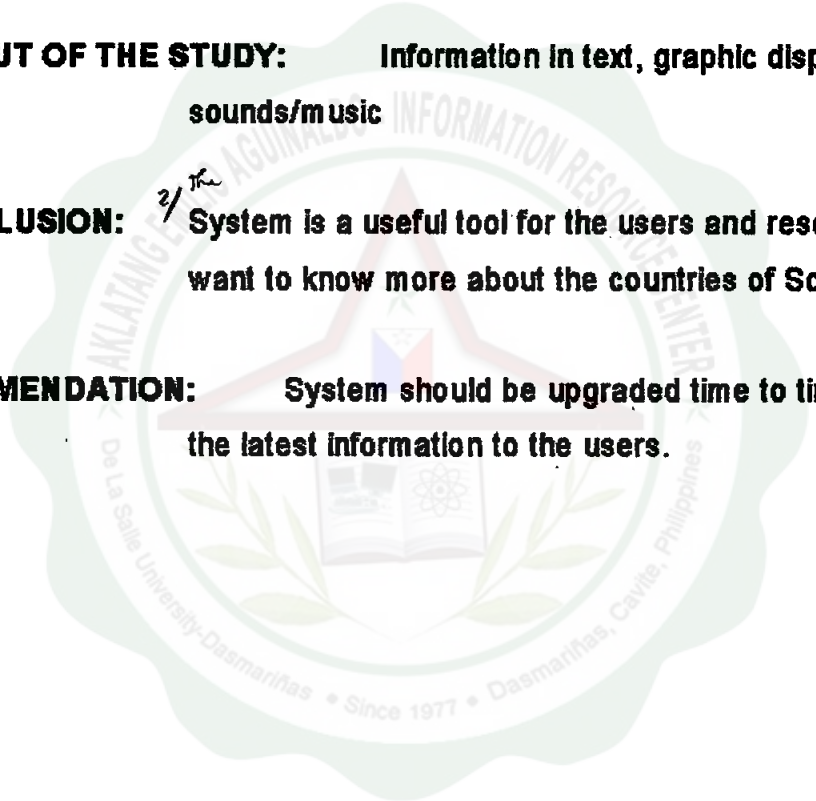
