



ABSTRACT

The Information System for Students Grade Distribution (SGD) of the De La Salle University - Dasmariñas was an attempt to utilize the benefits that computer technology can offer, to address the information needs for grades, university wide. SGD is a stand-alone DOS-based application system using Clipper version 5.2. It is designed to provide general information to faculty members about their students by providing easy and efficient way of processing, accessing and retrieving data. Specifically, it assists them in the computation of their final grades. It generates reports that are time-consuming if done manually. Such reports are class final grades and a summarized individual grade, which could easily be given to students instead of their class cards. It also comes in handy, the individual faculty load for their quick reference. Moreover, it will not only serve the faculty and students, but the registrar, dean, and the department chairman as well, who receive their respective copy of grades as their files.
