 - 6.1 Main Problem: To present an integrative review of the research outputs in educational administration of the graduate students of Philippine Normal College from 1972 to 1987.
 - 6.2 Sub-Problems: To produce the following:
 - 6.2.1 A profile of the theses and dissertations defended from 1972 to 1987;




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- 6.2.2 A bibliographic listing, an annotated bibliography and abstracts of the said research outputs;
 - 6.2.3 A synthesis of similarities and differences of findings in similar studies;
 - 6.2.4 An analysis of the possible causes for observed differences of findings of similar studies;
 - 6.2.5 An analysis of trends in educational practices from which future orientations/directions may be inferred; and
 - 6.2.6 A summary of areas that need further research.
7. Research Design: Descriptive-Analytical (qualitative approach of integrative review)
 8. Sampling Technique: All graduate theses were included
 9. Statistical Treatments: Descriptive statistics such as percentages.
10. Conclusion:
 - 10.1 Educational Research at the moment is still in its professional infancy. It provides only a little help for teachers and administration. Perhaps, if there were more graduates annually, there could be a more valuable, systematic and coherent study of a considerable series of related problem. Thus, new theories, generalizations and innovations useful for educators could be presented, investigated, developed and verified.
 11. Major Recommendations:
 - 11.1 Integrative reviews of researches on educational administration/management may be conducted in other schools. Succeeding review could use the Infante's Evaluation Criteria (1985).



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- 11.2 Research integration at a national level may be done periodically to have a more effective linkage among graduate schools and between the educational research group and the educational-consumer group who represents the teachers, administrators, parents and citizens.
- 11.3 Management areas which merited less attention as well as those which were not studied at all should be explored by future researchers. These cover issues in: Administrative and Faculty Development; Institutional Case Studies and Development Plans; Legal Aspects In Education; Students' Admission and Selection; Employee Relationship; Non-Academic Personnel; Community and Vocational Schools; Special Services; Organizational Structure and Control; School Finance; Administration of Physical Facilities; Teaching Effectiveness; and History and Development.



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
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
