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Abstract

Bustao is an online computer aided instruction that teaches statistics for 2nd year college course students taking up Bachelor of Science in Business Administration, Major in Marketing Management at La Consolacion College - Biñan. It is a system that helps students visualizes objects that are difficult to view and understand. The system helps in teaching that can be presented on computer in a form of text, videos, animations and speech.
