Archery arrived in mankind long before the beginning of the earliest civilization. It is one of the most vital tool necessary for survival, defense and food. In comparison to ancient times, same mental and physical strength are necessary to shoot a certain target with accuracy and precision in a modern competitive archery format. In the Philippines, competitive archery flourished during the late 1970's to 1980's and has begun its unfortunate decline over the years. The government's lesser focus and prioritization on sports had created a significant effect on the improvement of the sports and construction of decent facilities for athletes in the country which includes the sport of archery.

The proposed study namely, Philippine National Center for Archery aims to improve, develop and promote the standpoint of archery in the country as a form of recreation and competitive sport.
