ABSTRACT

Title: **An Evaluation of the Security Measures Implemented at Cavite State University System**

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The study is highly quantitative in nature; hence, descriptive method of research was used and self-made survey questionnaire as the data gathering instrument. The study utilized 4 sets of respondents – students, security personnel, full-time teachers, administrators – with a total of 1250. For the student-respondents and teacher-respondents, convenience sampling was used. For security personnel, complete enumeration was used. And for administrators, 2 each for the 5 big campuses (Indang, Naic, Silang, Carmona, and Cavite City) and 1 each for the 5 small campuses (Maragondon, TreceMartirez City, Tanza, General Trias, and Imus) were utilized. Various statistical tools were applied to treat the data gathered and to further determine the relationships that exist among the variables – percentage, weighted mean, and t- test (also called Student’s T Test).

Based on the findings of the study, the following conclusions were drawn: While security profession requires physical strength and firm decision-



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making strategy, it is a male-dominated profession; As all educational institutions across the Archipelago aspire for quality security management program to protect the interest of all the stakeholders, Cavite State University does the same although the assessment on the level of implementation, in general, received **moderately implemented** to **implemented** descriptive ratings while the highest is **highly implemented**; Like stress that no one is spared from experiencing it, problems are always part of any organization as Cavite State University, likewise, experiences on a moderate level; and People differ in their perception as majority of the respondents' assessments on the parameters evaluated were found to have significant differences.

And based on the findings and conclusions of the study, the following are hereby recommended: As the assessment in all the parameters evaluated, in general, received only **moderately implemented** to **implemented** descriptive ratings, the University management must exhaust all the possible means to achieve total quality security management program; The University management must have a thorough supervision on the implementation of its security programs and have a regular evaluation to check the problems that arise to give immediate attention before they totally become worst; The University must conduct yearly orientation of its security management program to all the administrators, teachers, staff, and students for them to be fully aware on how this is carried out in the campus. To this, they may have total commitment and involvement to sustain its



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effectiveness; The University must implement and use the proposed program of the study. Other educational institutions might consider using it, as well; and Future researcher may conduct studies on the same topic but must consider and explore other variables that were not included in the present study.
