## ABSTRACT

This study aimed to present the performance assessment of Campaign Finance Unit in regulating, monitoring, and evaluating the campaign funds and expenditures of the 2013 official senatorial candidates last May 2013 mid-term National Election. The Campaign Finance Unit concrete plans and their specific functions were considered. Information gathered through online news and published news were also included since the 2012 mid-term National Election was covered by media.
